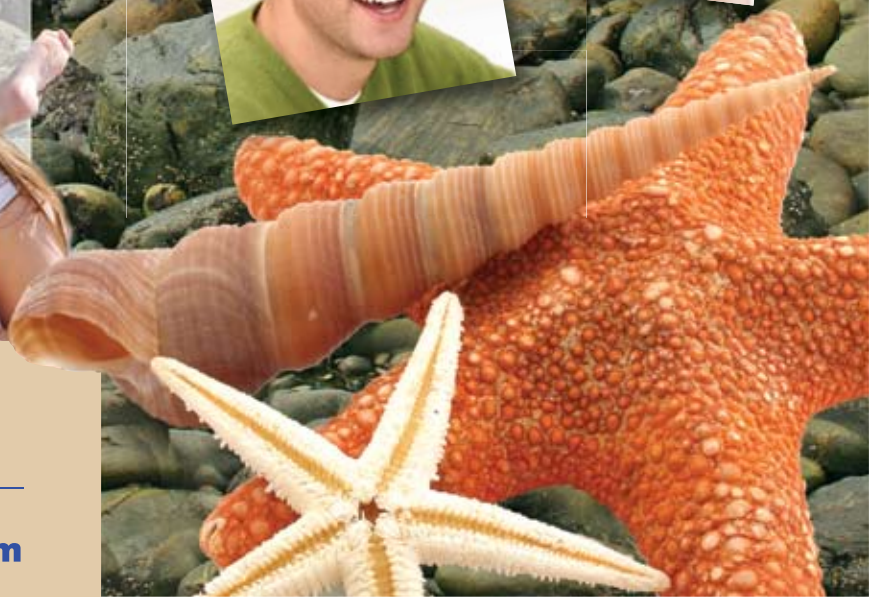

First Visit

The first visit to Shoreline Orthodontics is an important experience for every patient. Every individual's orthodontic problem is unique and deserves personalized attention. Dr. Helpard and his caring staff will provide a thorough clinical examination and careful explanation of the issues of concern. You will find the first visit to be a relaxing and informal experience.

Digital radiographs or a Cone Beam 3D dental CAT scan and photographs are taken at the initial visit to supplement the clinical exam. This allows us to see your teeth and jaws more clearly. If treatment is indicated, you may be given the opportunity to start the process on that day. We will take study models and all the details about orthodontic treatment will be explained. There will be opportunity to ask questions and a summary letter will be provided to you and your dentist.

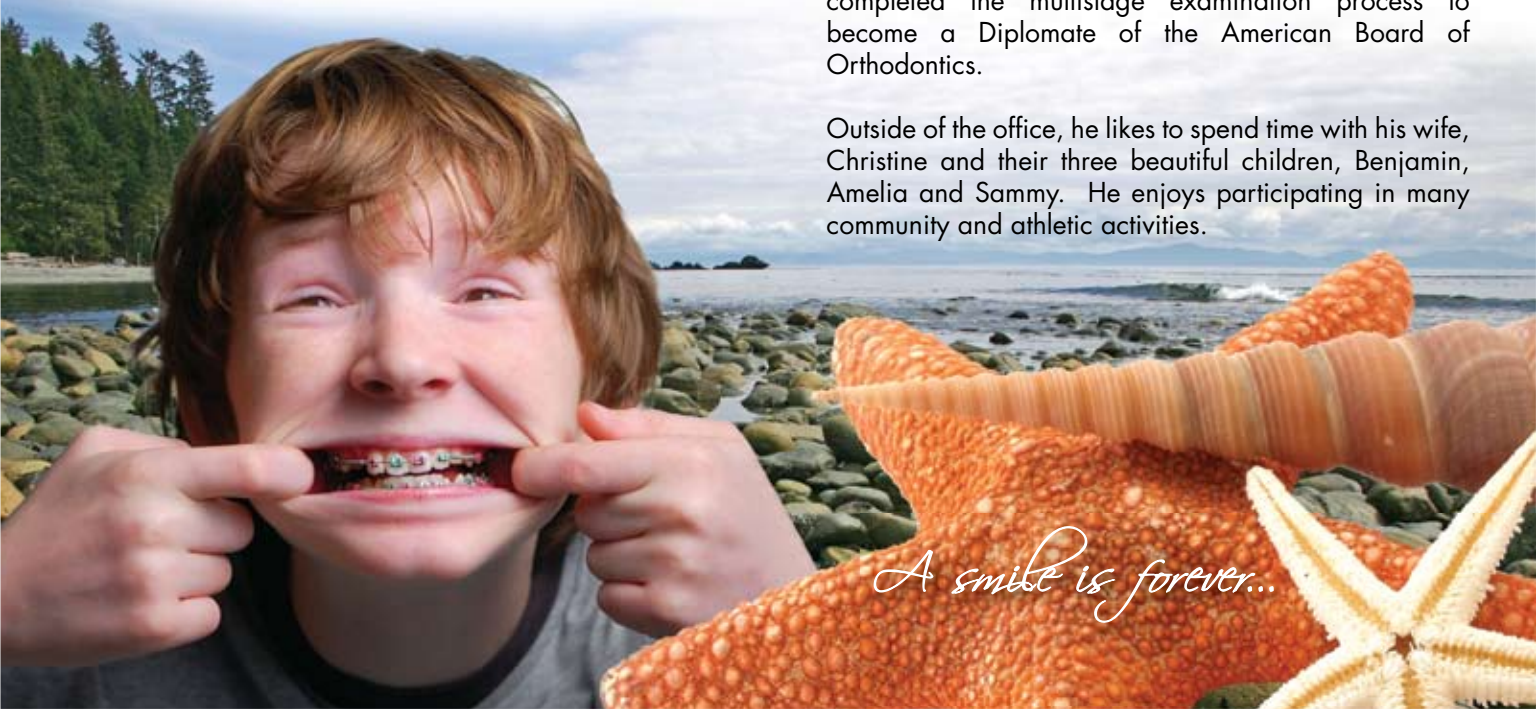
